Lavenham Neighbourhood Plan Questions for Babergh and Mid Suffolk planning officers (development management and planning policy). 16.04.21

Introduction:

The Lavenham Neighbourhood Plan became part of the district's statutory development plan in 2016. Five years on we have taken upon ourselves to review and update thus ensuring our changing needs are reflected. In this period Babergh District Council (jointly with Mid Suffolk District Council) is updating its district-level Local Plan. Q8: We are considering commissioning a Village Design Guide and are interested to understand if this would be considered a useful document to sit alongside the LNP?

Q9: Finally, please confirm what role you undertake for example, development management, planning policy, other? If there is anything else you feel would help us please add it in to your response.
